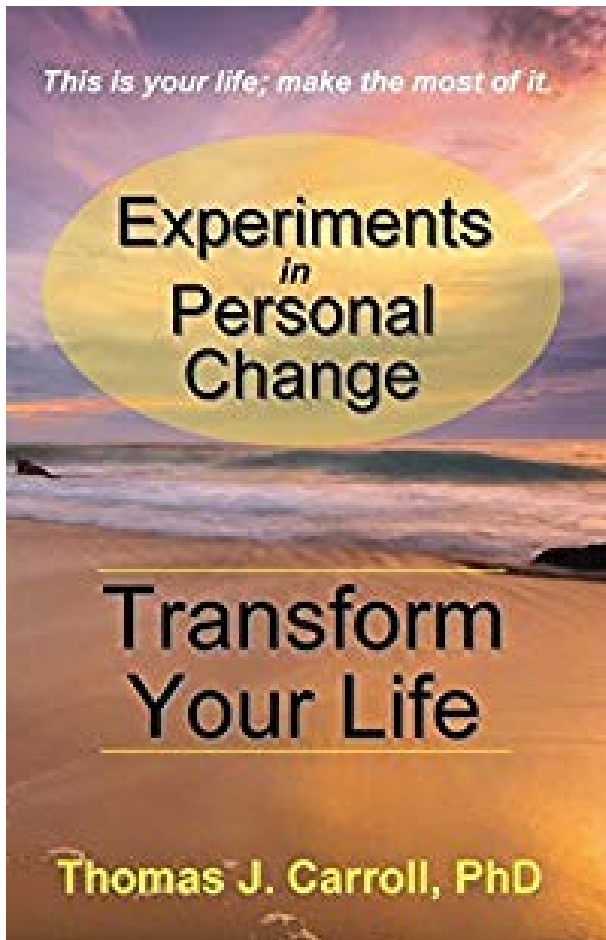


Experiments in Personal Change: Transform Your Life
